

Book Swap Guidelines

Books must be GRADE LEVEL INTEREST LEVEL.

6th Graders must trade books on a 6th grade interest level or YA level.

5th Graders must trade books on a 5th or 6th grade interest level.

4th Graders must trade books on a 4th, 5th or 6th grade interest level.

Books must be in “LIKE NEW” CONDITION.

White pages, NO YELLOWED, CRINKLED, OR TORN PAGES.

Pristine covers, NO YELLOWED, CRINKLED, OR TORN COVERS.

Books must be of CURRENT INTEREST for students in grades 4 – 6.

Publication date should be 2002 or later.

If earlier publication date and meets criteria above, make sure the topic is current.

Most children like:

Scary stories

Animal stories

Gross stories

Humor

Mystery

Fantasy/Science Fiction

Adventure

Stories about children their age.

Stories that have been on TV or at the Movies.

NOTE: Anything you bought through book clubs and book fairs recently, will be of current interest to students.

Books that meet these guidelines are accepted at US Publisher Value.

VOUCHERS MAY BE WRITTEN FOR PUBLISHER VALUE up to \$50.

Vouchers that would exceed \$50.00 need librarian's approval and will most likely be split into \$50 increments, with \$50 being spent during “grade level rush hour” and the remaining \$50 being spent after ALL “grade level rush hours” are completed.

Books that meet at least 2 of the guidelines and have librarian's approval

may be accepted for half of the US publisher value and will be swapped for half of the value.
